

Freedom Activity Camp

The Camps

Freedom Activity Camps are held at Grainville School, during both weeks of the Easter holidays, the May/June half term week and during the first five weeks of the Summer holidays every year.

The Activities



The activities vary according to the season but children can choose from **Sports:** (a variety of sports normally comprising mini cricket, football, dodgeball, softball, tennis and short tennis. (the mixture will depend on the size of the group and their preferences).), **Art, Craft and Pottery, Dance and Drama.**

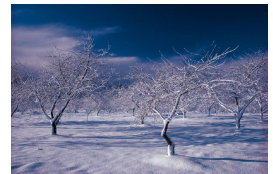
Covid We comply with all of the Government regulations regarding Covid and we are inspected by CEYS, from the Education Department. At the current time, the guidelines demand that children would be kept in bubbles although this may change before the camps commence.

The Timetable

Each day begins at 9:30 and finishes at 3:30 with a break for lunch at 12:30. *Participants may be dropped off from 8:30, will have access to a variety of games and playground equipment and will be fully supervised until the morning activities commence.* During the morning session, the coaches will concentrate on improving basic techniques and ability within your chosen activity, whilst the afternoon sessions will be more fun based with the emphasis on activity and enjoyment.. Children enrolled for more than one week will automatically be able to select different activities for subsequent weeks if desired.

Weather

In the event of rain we may have to replace some of the outside activities with the option of inside games. This will only be done if it becomes necessary and children will revert to their outside choices when the weather permits.



The Staff

The coaches are all teachers, childcare workers, qualified coaches or students specifically chosen for their knowledge of a particular sport or activity and their understanding of the needs and requirements of young children in these situations. All staff are police checked, child protection trained and first aid trained. We aim to maintain a ratio of 8:1 in all of our groups.

What you need



You need to wear suitable clothing for your chosen activity, a packed lunch (no fizzy drinks please), and plenty of energy and enthusiasm. There is no need to bring your own equipment, (tennis racquets etc.) all the necessary equipment will be provided. Please do not bring valuables or money; we cannot be responsible for their security

Booking

In order to secure a place a completed application form and a deposit of £20 per child for each camp is required with the balance to be paid on the first day of each camp. Some activities are very popular and numbers limited by safety factors so it is advisable to book early if a particular activity is desired. If you are downloading an application form, please be sure to tick the dates that you require. The cost of a five day camp is £175 and may be paid by PAYPAL if desired. The cost covers all tuition, supervision and the use of all equipment and facilities. A 10% discount is now given when one more children from the same family attend together or where a child already attends one of Freedom's After School Clubs.

Cancellation

If for any reason, we cancel any camps, all money paid will be refunded in full.

Participants

Boys and girls from reception age to 13 are welcome to come along and take part in the activities. Younger children are monitored very carefully and if it is felt that any children are having difficulty coping within the main group, they will be offered a place in a smaller group continuing with less rigorous activities. Parents will be informed if this affects their children and further, any parents who feel this may be the most appropriate option for their children should speak with the manager. There is no extra cost for this option.

After Camp Supervision

As an extension of the After School Clubs operated by Freedom Activity Camp, there is the opportunity for parents to choose to have their children remain on premises and continue with different activities until no later than 5:30. The children will at 3:30 be taken to Drama Room school and will remain there until collected by a parent. Once there, the children will be provided with a substantial snack and will have access to several board games, art materials, books and toys. This facility is aimed at primary aged children and if required, should be booked at the time of application. You do not need to book the whole week, you may opt for as many or as few days as you wish to have. There is an additional cost of £11 per afternoon for this extension to the camp.

Administration

Overall responsibility for the administration of the club and the organisation of the activities will be in the hands of Jim Westwater and Mo McDonald. Jim is an experienced educational administrator and has run Freedom Activity Camp for over 35 years. Mo is an experienced teacher and has been a club manager for several years.
